Read Luke 19:1-10

What do you know about tax collectors?

- To what profession would you compare a tax collector in our culture?

How do you think Zaccheus felt being a part of the crowd watching Jesus?

- What do you think Zaccheus hoped to accomplish by climbing a tree?
- When have you been most desperate to "see" Jesus?
- What did you do in order to "see" Jesus?

Why did the people grumble when Jesus chose to go to Zaccheus' house?

Why did Zaccheus volunteer to give away so much of his wealth?

- How do you explain Zaccheus' sudden change in perspective on money?
- Where do you see the results of the love of money in our culture?
- What would you tell someone who is consumed by the desire for material things?
- How do they get out from under the control of that obsession?
- Why should "salvation" (v. 9) affect a person's love of money?

How does Jesus' statement of purpose in verse 10 answer the crowd's complaint about Him going to Zaccheus' house in verse 7?

- How can we model Jesus' priorities and actions in this passage?
