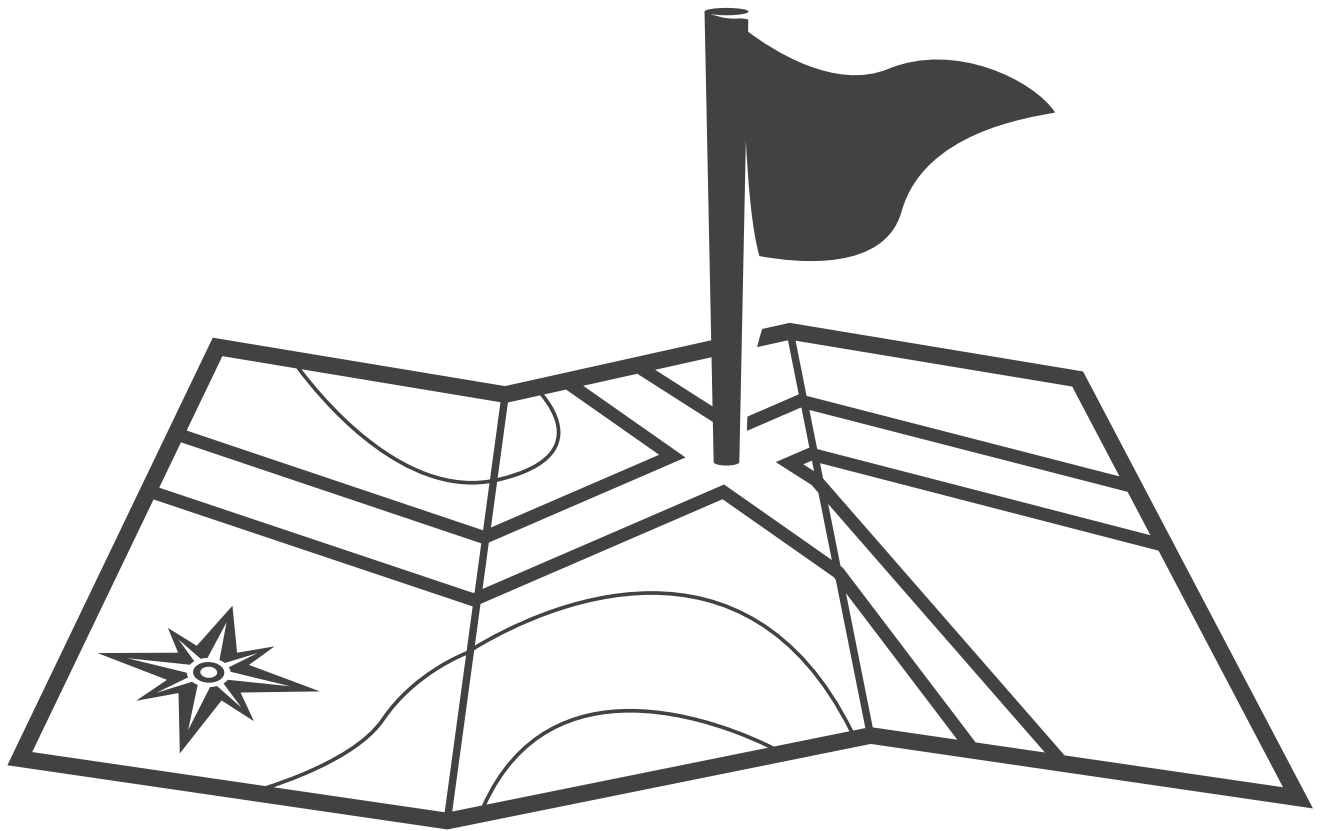

COMMUNITY GROUP HOST OR LEADER

- YEAR ROUND

The Group Leader facilitates discussion, asks questions and shares personal experiences to establish a welcoming small group environment that encourages attenders to grow closer to Christ and in community together. The Group Host provides the home/hospitality for the small group. Time/day are decided by the group. Commitments for one year is preferred.

CONNECTION POINTE TABLE HOST

- 1ST & 3RD SUNDAYS
- 10:45AM - 12:00PM

The Table Host facilitates discussion, ask questions and shares personal experiences to establish a small-group environment that encourages people who are interested in taking the next step in connecting by either beginning their own small group or joining an existing group.

MEN'S MINISTRY LEADER & CO-LEADER

- SATURDAYS
- WEEKLY
- 8:00AM

The Men's Leader/Co-Leader facilitates a group of men through Bible studies, DVD series and other curriculum. Each study is built around small-group discussion and life-application questions.

Connection Ministries

MOM2MOM TABLE LEADER

- 1ST & 3RD THURSDAYS
- 9:00AM - 11:00AM

The Table Leader facilitates a table of mothers during the morning gathering of MOM2MOM, which includes a morning devotional, breakfast and a chance to recharge while your children are being watched for you.

MOM2MOM CHILDCARE

- 1ST & 3RD THURSDAYS
- 9:00AM - 11:00AM

Childcare is provided for birth to preschool age children while their mom attends MOM2MOM ministry. This team provides childcare at the church during the time they meet. A background check is required.

WOMEN'S MINISTRY CHILDCARE

- WEEKLY ON TUESDAYS
- 7:00PM-9:00PM

Childcare is provided for our Women's Tuesday night Bible study. This involves two hours of care and play-time with children. A background check is required.

WOMEN'S MINISTRY TABLE LEADER

- WEEKLY ON TUESDAYS
- 7:00PM-9:00PM

The Table Leader facilitates a group of women through Bible studies, DVD series and other curriculum. Each study is built around small-group discussion and life-application questions.

Facilities

The appearance of our building, both inside and out, is a vital part of our first impression to those attending and those simply driving by. The facilities team keeps our building and grounds clean and welcoming.

These are great serving options to do together as a family.

CLEANING TEAM

- **WEEKDAYS/NIGHTS**
- **WEEKLY TWICE A MONTH**

The Cleaning Team assist with light cleaning duties during the weekdays or weeknights. Duties include: vacuuming, trash collection, wiping surfaces/tables, sweeping and making sure main areas are tidy and ready for use.

GROUNDS TEAM

- **FLEXIBLE TIMING BASED ON AVAILABILITY**
- **TWICE A MONTH**

The seasonal Grounds team handles: weeding, edging, and leaf blowing.

MAINTENANCE TEAM

- **PREFERABLY THURSDAYS, BUT FLEXIBLE**
- **DAYS OR EVENINGS AS AVAILABLE**

The Maintenance Team assists with building/grounds repairs and fixes throughout the church.

SPECIAL PROJECTS TEAM

- **SATURDAYS**
- **QUARTERLY OR PRIOR TO MAJOR HOLIDAYS/SPECIAL EVENTS**
- **9:00AM-1:00PM**

Assist with building/grounds projects needed for special programs or one-time needs.

Guest Services

The Guest Service team provides a warm, informative presence to visitors and regular attendees.

INFORMATION CENTER ATTENDANT

- **SUNDAYS**
- **ONCE OR TWICE A MONTH**
- **30 MINUTES BEFORE EACH SERVICE AND 15 MINUTES AFTER SERVICE STARTS**

The Information Center Attendant welcomes visitors, answers questions, assist with event registration and helps people find areas to engage or connect.

GREETERS

- **SUNDAYS**
- **MONTHLY OR BI-MONTHLY**
- **40 MIN (20 MINUTES BEFORE AND 20 MINUTES INTO WORSHIP SERVICES)**

Greeters are the first connection for visitors and regular attendees. Their actions say, "We're glad you're here; welcome home." Greeters set the stage for people's experience at North Pointe.

KIDS WORLD CHECK-IN ATTENDANT

- **SUNDAYS**
- **WEEKLY OR TWICE A MONTH**
- **1 HOUR DURING WORSHIP SERVICES**

The Kids World Check-in Attendant extends a warm welcome while enrolling families into Kids World. Creating an environment of competence and care for the child is vital for parents to have a good experience at church. If kids are safely and happily enrolled, everyone is happy! A background check is required.

USHERS

- **SUNDAYS**
- **MONTHLY OR WEEKLY**
- **1 HOUR DURING WORSHIP SERVICES**

Ushers play a vital role in setting the stage for an attendee's worship experience. An Usher extends a warm welcome into the service, distributes bulletins, assures a place to sit and takes care of any needs throughout the service. Accomplishing these responsibilities in a positive, caring manner communicates much to an attendee.

Kids World Ministry

At North Pointe, we want kids to be excited to come to church. Our Kids Ministry focuses on bringing children to a real and active relationship with God at an early age. Serving opportunities on Sundays: room leader or co-leader, praise and worship leader, drama, media, crafts, computer check-in and more. Find joy and fulfillment investing in our next generation.

CHECK-IN TEAM

- SUNDAYS
- EVERY OTHER WEEK
- 30 BEFORE EACH SERVICE & 15 MINUTES INTO EACH SERVICE

The Check-In Team greets families as they enter our Kids World areas, assist with Check-In Kiosk, check security badges and promotes the safety of our children. A background check is required.

ELEMENTARY TEACHERS AND HELPERS

- SUNDAYS
- WEEKLY OR TWICE A MONTH
- DURING WORSHIP SERVICES, 9:30AM or 11:00AM
- ALL SCHOOL-AGE CLASSROOMS AVAILABLE

Lead or assist the leader with teaching and activities for our elementary-age students about Jesus in a fun and engaging manner that promotes not only knowledge, but the experience of Jesus, while providing a safe and welcoming atmosphere for both the child and the parents. A background check is required.

NURSERY AND TODDLER CARE

- SUNDAYS
- WEEKLY OR TWICE A MONTH
- DURING WORSHIP SERVICES

Our Nursery and Toddler workers provide supervision and care for our youngest attendees. Hold babies and play with toddlers for an hour of pure fun. Serve year-round or only during the summer months. A background check is required.

SHINE - SPECIAL NEEDS MINISTRY

- SUNDAYS
- WEEKLY OR TWICE A MONTH

Shine provides a unique, rewarding opportunity to help children with special needs experience and learn about Jesus. Each helper is paired up with a student to befriend and assist, enabling them to engage in the activities. A background check is required.

Kids World Ministry

MID-WEEK OFFICE SUPPORT

- WEEKDAYS
- WEEKLY

Assist with the administrative tasks of our Kids Ministry. Office volunteers must be willing to do various office tasks and computer skills, an understanding of Microsoft Office is preferable.

Safety Team

We desire to give due diligence to provide a safe environment for our children and adults while attending services, programs, and activities at North Pointe. This team is composed of people who have been trained in any field of emergency response, law enforcement, or military...or people who have received a certain level of training in safety protocol.

SAFETY TEAM

- SUNDAYS 8:00AM-12:15PM & OTHER VARIOUS EVENT TIMES

The Safety Team assists in creating and implementing safety protocol, training, and maintaining a safe and secure environment. Commitment level is flexible. A background check is required.

Student Ministry

The Student Ministry offers exciting and challenging opportunities for students to encounter God and develop meaningful relationships. We desire for students to gain ownership of their faith and truly experience how much fun it is to live the life God intended them to live.

HIGH SCHOOL SMALL GROUP LEADERS

- SUNDAYS
- WEEKLY
- 5:00PM-9:00PM

Small-group leaders hang out with our high school students, build relationships and lead/co-leading small-group discussion. You will partner with another adult leader as you pour into a small group of students by grade and/or gender. A background check is required.

LEADER MEALS TEAM

- SUNDAYS
- ONCE A MONTH

The Leader Meals Team serves together to prepare and provide a meal as a “thank you” to the middle school and high school leaders.

MIDDLE SCHOOL SMALL GROUP LEADERS

- WEDNESDAYS
- WEEKLY
- 5:45PM-9:00PM

Small-group leaders hang out with our middle school students, build relationships and lead/co-leading small-group discussion. You will partner with another adult leader as you pour into a small group of students by grade and gender. A background check is required.

WEEKDAY OFFICE SUPPORT

- WEEKDAYS
- FLEXIBLE TIMES

Office support is a way to invest in our students by involvement in the organization and preparation of Student Ministry events, dealing with the administrative details and implementation of planned events.

Worship Team

This team has the privilege of connecting people to God through music during our worship services. Desired skill levels vary; most positions require auditions.

WORSHIP TEAM

- **SUNDAYS & WEDNESDAYS OR THURSDAYS**
- **FLEXIBLE SCHEDULE**
- **SUNDAYS 8:00AM-12:15PM, WEDNESDAY/THURSDAYS 7:00PM-9:00PM**

Play or sing with our worship band and lead our church in worship through music. Vocal and instrumental positions are available; auditions required.

STAGE DESIGN TEAM

- **FLEXIBLE DAYS AND TIMES**
- **4 HOURS PER MONTH**

The Stage Design Team creates new stage sets for sermon series and programs using props, lights, and light construction. This involves painting, graphic design, and construction.

VISUALS AND LIGHTS ASSISTANTS

- **SUNDAY MORNING**
- **ONCE OR TWICE MONTHLY**
- **4 HOURS**

The Visuals and Lights Assistants work with our computer programs to display lyrics, videos pictures, and other media during each service. This position also runs and creates the lighting designs that compliment our worship sets during each service. All skill levels welcome; training provided.

SOUND ASSISTANTS

- **SUNDAY MORNING**
- **ONCE OR TWICE MONTHLY**
- **4 HOURS**

Sound Assistants operate our soundboard and balances the sound needs of our Worship Team, media, pastors and speakers for each service. All skill levels welcome; training provided.

Campbell Elementary

Campbell Elementary is a school that many of our families attend. We are committed to serving at Campbell by partnering with their Community Learning Center after-school program and other opportunities as they arise.

COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTER

- DURING SCHOOL DAYS/HOURS
- WEEKLY

This opportunity involves leading or assisting with an after-school club, i.e., helping a student with homework or assisting with an interest-based club. It's a chance to build into a young life in a positive way; a testimony of care to both the child and to the school.

Haiti - International

SHORT-TERM MISSIONS TEAMS

- TEAMS LEAVE TWICE A YEAR (JUNE & DECEMBER)
- \$1400-\$1600 A TRIP
- WEEK LONG TRIPS

Partner with us in Haiti in our relational mission to help those in need in the community of Montrious, Haiti. We currently work through Jacob's Well Institute School by...

- Hosting teacher workshops for 20+ teachers at their school,
- Facilitating a community-based Vacation Bible School program for kids, and
- Working with the provision of micro-loans for adults desiring to start a business in Haiti.

Each member is responsible for raising their own funds for the trip. We encourage return trips because our involvement in Haiti is more than just a one-time destination. Our commitment to them is an ongoing, relational-based commitment with the goal of building and investing in the lives of Haitians as we return every six months.

Jacob's Well

Jacob's Well is a community-based, non-profit organization in the shadows of the State Capitol Building. Jacob's Well is a home and a ministry that serves their neighborhood. It's a place where kids come to hang out and hear about Jesus. The events and programs center around the physical, relational, and spiritual needs of that specific community. Their hallmark is how they meet those needs. With authenticity of heart, people are their focus, meeting them as they are and where they are.

KIDS AT THE WELL

- WEDNESDAY NIGHT
- FLEXIBLE SCHEDULE

Kids at the Well is a weekly program for the kids who live in the Jacob's Well area. The kids arrive shortly after school and are provided with a safe place to do homework, hear Bible stories, eat a warm meal, and enjoy craft time. An opportunity to invest in the lives of urban kids that could change their lives for eternity.

FOOD DISTRIBUTION SATURDAY

- SATURDAY MORNINGS
- FLEXIBLE SCHEDULE
- 9:30AM-12:00PM

Assist people in need by helping with the distribution of free food. This is done at the First Presbyterian Church (840 So. 17th Street), every 1st and 3rd Saturday of the month. Meet at the church at 9:30am; food distribution starts at 10:00am.

North Star High School

North Star High School is the hub of our community. It is where many of our families attend school and, for many in the community, it is a source of needed resources. We have a partnership with the high school through our involvement with their Community Learning Center, plus many other partnerships throughout the school year.

APPLY-TO-COLLEGE DAY

- OCTOBER
- ONE-TIME-EVENT
- 8:00AM-12:00PM

Assist juniors and seniors in applying for college in the Media Center at the school. Many of these students need help navigating the college application, filling out the FAFSA forms or other financial forms. A little support helps them take a big step.

North Star High School

COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTER

- DURING SCHOOL DAYS/HOURS
- WEEKLY

Engage by leading or assisting leadership in helping students with homework or getting involved in an interest-based club. Partner with students by taking a genuine interest in them, building into their lives in a positive way.

JOB SHADOWING HOST

- 3-6 HOURS DURING THE SCHOOL DAY
- FALL AND/OR SPRING

If your workplace is open to offer job shadowing opportunities for high school students, sign up to become a host workplace for juniors who desire to shadow an employee at a job of possible interest. The potential impact this opportunity has for a student's life is great.

SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT TEAM

- SCHOOL YEAR
- MONTHLY DURING THE LUNCH HOUR
- HOURS VARY

Join a team of local businesses, community members, and parents of North Star students each month as we work with school administration on ways to improve the school and community. If you work at a local business or are a parent at North Star, this is a tangible way to have a supportive presence and voice in the community over a lunch hour.

TEACHING APPRECIATION TEAM

- SCHOOL YEAR
- TYPICALLY DURING THE SCHOOL DAY
- HOURS VARY

As a team, create ways to show appreciation and gratefulness to the teachers at North Star.

TEAMMATES PROGRAM

- DURING SCHOOL DAYS/HOURS
- WEEKLY

Meet with one student regularly throughout the school year to build into his/her life. This investment of time has potential to make a great impact on lives. A background check is required.

People's City Mission

Since 1907, the People's City Mission has been where all of Lincoln's less fortunate could find shelter and a warm meal. They've grown to be Lincoln's safety net for the community. Their mission is to be a witness for Christ among the poor and homeless, serve their needs, and advocate their cause to the community.

MEAL SERVE

- 18 YEARS OF AGE
- SERVE SUPPER 4:45PM-7:00PM - 2ND MONDAY/MONTHLY
- SERVE LUNCH 11:00AM-1:30PM - EVERY 4TH TUESDAY

Serve three warm meals to those in need at the People's City Mission with our team for either supper or lunch at the People's City Mission. This is an easy way to give back your time to help those in need.

Yezidi Outreach

The largest population of Yezidis in the USA live in Lincoln. Many Yezidis have experienced genocide first-hand and have fled to Lincoln to start a new life. We partner with this people group in any way possible to share the love of Christ with them. As we develop this new outreach, new opportunities will arise.

ENGLISH CLASSES

- MONDAY NIGHT
- FLEXIBLE SCHEDULE
- 6:30PM-8:00PM

Help Yezidi men and women learn basic English words and simple phrases to help them adjust to life in Lincoln. You will be partnered with a Yezidi adult and, based on the theme for that night, you will work with them to learn words and phrases in English. No prior ESL or ELL experience needed.

ENGLISH CLASSES CHILDCARE

- MONDAY NIGHT
- FLEXIBLE SCHEDULE
- 6:00PM-8:00PM

Provide childcare for Yezidis taking English classes, which allows the adults to have an optimum learning environment. A background check is required.
